## 1. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND VISAS

A full British passport, valid for the duration of the visit only, is required to enter mainland Spain, the Balearic and Canary Islands.

EU, Norway, Iceland and Switzerland citizens do not require visas for visits whatever their length.

Holders of passports valid for the entire period of the visit, issued by Australia, Canada, Japan and the USA do not require visas for visits of under 90 days, but a special visa is required for longer stays.

All other nationals should contact the Spanish Consular authorities.

### 3. ACCOMMODATION

Most accommodation is provided in Hotels, classified from 1 to 5 stars, as well as Hostels or Pensions, classified from 1 to 3 stars. There are other types of accommodation available in Apartment-Hotels, Hotel-Residencias, Hostal-Residencias and Motels. The term Residencia denotes an establishment where dining-room facilities are not provided, though there may be breakfast and cafeteria services. There is also a network of Paradores from 3 to 5 stars all over the country. Bookings may be made with the following agencies:

Hotel ratings are granted by the regional governments and standards may vary from region to region. The following is a general guide only

*FIVE STAR HOTELS:* Air-conditioning in all public rooms and bedrooms; central heating; all bedrooms with private bathrooms; some suites with sitting room; telephone in every room; lounge and adequate parking facilities.

*FOUR STAR HOTELS:* Air conditioning in all public rooms and bedrooms unless climatic conditions require central heating or refrigeration only; lounge; all bedrooms with private bathroom; hot and cold water; telephone in every room; lift; adequate parking facilities.

*THREE STAR HOTELS:* Air-conditioning/heating according to climatic conditions; lounge; all bedrooms with bathroom/shower, wash-basin, WC and hot and cold water; telephone in every room.

*TWO STAR HOTELS:* Air-conditioning/heating according to climatic conditions; lounge; all bedrooms with bath/shower; wash-basin, WC and hot and cold water; telephone.

*ONE STAR HOTELS:* Air-conditioning/heating according to climatic conditions; lounge; all bedrooms with bath/shower; wash-basin, WC and hot and cold water; telephone.

*TAXES:* all categories: 7% Mainland and Balearic Islands; 4.5% IGIC in the Canary Islands and IPSI in Ceuta (3%) and Melilla (2%)

*BOOKING:* It is always advisable to book accommodation well in advance, particularly during festivals or in popular resorts on the coast from late Spring to October. Reservations may be made by writing direct to the hotels, list of which may be obtained from this office, or through travel agents or certain hotel booking services. Letters to 3, 4 or 5 star hotels may be written in English, but it is advisable to write in Spanish to lower categories. *REDUCTIONS FOR CHILDREN:* Although not regulated, most hotels offer reductions for babies and small children. These are to be negotiated directly with the hotel.

*COMPLAINTS:* All hotels, restaurants, camp sites and petrol stations are required by law to keep and produce complaint forms when required by a client to do so. Should you be unable to obtain these, you are advised to obtain them from the Tourist Information Office when possible, or write to the Dirección General de Turismo (addresses available from this office) of the appropriate Autonomous Government, enclosing all factual evidence, within a month of the incident

## 4. MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

**Babies:** Baby foods and disposable nappies are available at all resorts and are obtainable from supermarkets and chemists. Babysitting arrangements can usually be made locally. The availability and costs should be checked with establishments directly or through the booking agent.

**Banking Hours:** Most banks open from 09.00-14.00 Monday to Friday and 09.00 to 13.00 on Saturdays (except in the summer). Times may vary.

**Church Services:** Information on the location of churches and timetables of religious services should be sought locally.

**Consular Assistance:** British Consulates in Spain will assist holidaymakers in emergencies. They can provide lists of local lawyers, interpreters and local doctors. They can also give guidance in tracing missing persons. Addresses are available from this office on request.

**Credit Cards:** Most hotels and department stores accept major credit cards, but this should be checked before each transaction.

**Currency:** Spain is in the Eurozone and the Euro (€) is the legal currency. There are seven denominations in notes - 5, 10, 20, 50, 100, 200 & 500 € - and eight different coins - 1 and 2 € and 1, 2, 5, 10, 20 and 50 cents. 1 € equals 166.386 Pesetas. *Exchange rate:* check with your bank or travel agent.

*Spanish currency regulations:* The import or export of cash, notes and bearer-cheques, in any currency, including Euros, is subject to declaration where the amount exceeds 10,000 € per person and journey.

**Duty Free:** Free allowances on imports from EU countries no longer exist but are still applicable to goods purchased outside the European Union. For information on imports into the UK contact Customs & Excise on 0845 010 9000. [www.hmrc.gov.uk](http://www.hmrc.gov.uk). Spanish customs regulations are more stringent on both imports and exports. Further information is available on request.

**Electricity:** Voltage 220 or 225 AC. Plugs are two pin.

**Excursions:** Information on excursions is available locally from tourist information offices and local travel agents.

**Health service:** British tourists visiting Spain, covered by the British National Insurance scheme, will enjoy free medical assistance under the Spanish Health Service during their stay provided they are in possession of the new European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). Application forms are available from the Post Office but can take up to 21 days, by telephone to EHIC Application Line on 0845 606 20 30 (10 days), or apply online at [www.dh.gov.uk/travellers](http://www.dh.gov.uk/travellers) to receive a card within 7 days. For further information please contact your local Health Authority.

*Medical Conditions:* Those requiring special treatment or diets are advised to carry a letter from their doctor translated into Spanish, indicating the nature of the condition, treatment and medicines required. Special dietary products are available from health shops and pharmacies. British Consulates may supply names and addresses of local doctors in emergencies.

**Imports:** Those wishing to import household goods, firearms, etc. into Spain need to contact the Spanish Consulates in the UK.

**Insurance:** You are advised to take out adequate holiday insurance. This is available from most tour operators, travel agents and airlines.

**Language Courses:** Information on Spanish courses, either in Spain or in the UK, is available from the Instituto Cervantes.

**Metal detectors:** Metal detecting is a strictly controlled activity in Spain and its practise in public places requires a permit from the relevant local council. Permits are normally granted for investigation purposes only.

**Museums:** All Spanish Estate museums\* offer free admission to young persons under 18 and to O.A.P over 65 as well as a free admission weekly sessions to the general public. Most other museums also have concessionary policies. Full details on fees and concessions must be obtained from the specific museums directly.

**Public Holidays:** January 1st & 6th, March 21st (Good Friday), May 1st, August 15th, October 12th, Nov 1st, Dec 6th, 8th & 25th. In addition to these holidays there are another five established by the regional authorities and the local councils; further information available on request.

**Shopping:** Most shops in Spain close at lunch time. (Lunch break is normally between 13.00 and 16.00). Most provincial capital towns have department stores: opening hours are normally from 10.00 to 20.00. Open Air Markets are held in most towns and holiday resorts: details about days and times may be obtained locally. Supermarkets, health food stores and chemists are to be found in most resorts.

**Summer Time:** From the morning of the last Sunday in March to the last Sunday in October.

**Taxis:** Taxi fares vary in different areas. There is a basic initial charge; additional surcharges will be added to the meter fare at night, weekends and public holidays. Taxi drivers should have a list of approved fares for inter-city runs, railway stations and airports, and will be able to supply information prior to boarding the vehicle.

**Tax refunds:** EU citizens are not entitled to tax refunds on purchases made in Spain. Further enquiries should be made to the Spanish Commercial Office.

**Telephone Service:** To call direct to the UK from Spain, dial: 00 44 + local UK code: Telephone rates need to be checked locally. Full instructions are shown in all international boxes. Dial 112 for all emergencies. Mobile phone companies will be able to advise on the geographical cover they offer.

**Televisions:** The Spanish television systems are Norma G for black and white and PAL for colour. British television sets are not suitable for either unless previously adjusted by a technician. For further information please contact your main dealer.

**Tippling:** 5-10% of the bill is customary, although related to clients' satisfaction with services received.

**Vaccinations:** According to the Spanish and World Health Organisations, no vaccinations are needed by EU residents to enter Spain.

**Weddings:** Foreign nationals may marry in Spain only if one of the parties is legally resident in Spain. Information on procedures must be sought from the local Civil Registry Office or from their national consulate for that area. Note should be taken that procedures are complicated and lengthy. For information on religious marriages, the relevant religious authority in Spain should be contacted.

**Car Hire Bookings:** Contact any of the international hire companies. Details of hire vehicles of special characteristics, bicycles and motor scooters should be requested from Local Tourist Offices in Spain. The minimum age to qualify for car hire is 21.

**Coach Hire Bookings:** Coaches, with driver, may be booked through Travel Agents.

**Insurance:** Third party insurance is compulsory in Spain. Travellers are advised to check with their insurers the terms of cover under their policy when driving in Spain.

**Traffic Offences:** On the spot payment of fines (reduced by 30%) is compulsory for non-residents.
